The workbench

- 1 large foam ball
- 15 medium sized long paper tubes
- 2 Plastic eyes
- 1 pom pom nose
- 8 pipe cleaners (include 1 red one for the mouth)
- 1 packet of feathers
- Poster paint (non toxic) and paint brush
- Scissors
- PVA glue
- 5 bells

Step 1.

Paint the foam ball all over with the poster paint (any colors). While the paint is still wet, finely cut up half of the feathers then roll the foam ball onto them, so the entire ball is covered with feathers.

Step 2.

Glue on the eyes and nose. Cut the red pipe cleaner to size and shape a wiggly mouth. Bend the very ends of the pipe cleaner and push them into the foam so the mouth sticks on securely.

Step 3.

Paint the paper tubes and roll onto the other half of the cut up feathers. Thread the 5 bells onto the 5 pipe cleaners at the end, bending and twisting the pipe cleaners to secure the bells 1cm from the edge. Thread 3 of the long tubes onto each pipe cleaner; bend the left over pipe cleaner to a 45 degree angle and push it into the foam so the legs dangle down. Have a play.
