



# Snowman

## The workbench

- 3 different sized foam balls
- Colored glitter (3 parts silver to 1 part other colors)
- Clag (do not use craft glue as it will disintegrate the foam)
- Colored buttons
- 1 glitter pom pom
- 3 skewers (kebab sticks)
- Tinsel
- 1 packet of mixed colored pipe cleaners
- 2 bells (craft retailers)
- 2 paper tube noodles (craft retailers)
- 2 push in plastic eyes

### Step 1.

Push a skewer through the bottom of the largest foam ball until it is all the way through, then thread on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> largest balls; cut off any remaining protruding stick.

### Step 2.

Paste clag all over the largest ball and sprinkle with a thick coat of glitter; repeat this process for the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> balls. Glue the buttons on down the front of the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> largest balls (refer to the picture), then tie the tinsel on between the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> largest balls. Push in the eyes, glue on the nose pom pom and cut to length the pipe cleaner to fit a mouth. Bend and push the ends into the foam to secure.

### Step 3.

Twist and join different colored pipe cleaners then wrap them around a tube noodle to achieve a curly look (refer to the picture); then wrap it around the snowman's neck for his scarf. Paste glue all over the tube noodles and sprinkle them with a thick layer of glitter. Thread a bell onto a pipe cleaner folding over the end and twisting to secure the bell, then using a skewer push it through the 2<sup>nd</sup> ball at arm length all the way through. Thread the pipe cleaner through the tube noodle and through the hole in the foam then thread on the other paper noodle and bell to secure the arms.
