



Indian headdress

The workbench

- Colored feathers
- Sticky tape
- A4 self-laminating sheets
- Hole punch
- Craft glue
- Sequins
- A4 sheet Colored paper (optional color)
- String
- Stapler
- Scissors
- Tracing paper

Step 1.

Using a sheet of tracing paper trace the pattern from the back of the book then retrace the design onto the colored paper cut two of the main headpiece and cut out the shapes. Open the self-laminating sheet and place 1 copy of the hat pieces inside, before closing chop up some feathers and place them on top of the paper. Cut out the hat then glue on sequins around the outer edges (refer to the picture). Sticky tape the main hat to the band at the base on 1 side only.

Step 2.

Turn the hat over to the back and tape on some feathers in a line following the hats topside all the way along, then apply some glue all over the base of the feathers and apply the second sheet of paper to the back to secure the feathers onto the hat.

Step 3.

Get an adult to wrap the hat around your head and measure a snug fit and staple it into place then attach some tape to secure it together. Hole punch 1 hole into the band in the middle then 1 hole on both sides of the first hole and attach a 30cm length of string into each hole. Tie on some feathers starting from the top of the string by knotting the string and placing the tip of the feathers inside the knot before tightening the string.
