



Fairy box bag

The workbench

- Fairy decoupage paper (craft retailers)
- Scotch tape
- Craft glue
- Estapol gloss or varnish
- Thick cardboard
- Scissors
- Butterfly and flower stickers or pictures
- Stapler and staples

Step 1.

Cut a heart shape out of the cardboard and cut a straight line across the bottom (refer to the picture). Trace another heart shape, using the 1st cut out heart as a pattern. Cut out a rectangle shape (bags bottom) making sure that the length is the same length as the straight bottom of the heart; make the width as large as you would like the bag width to be. Cut out 2 more rectangles (bag sides) the same width as the bags bottom rectangle (refer to the picture) and the length as long as you want it to go up the side of the hearts. Cut out a cardboard strap long enough to go over the shoulder.

Step 2.

Lay all the pieces out flat (refer to the picture) and stick them together with scotch tape. Turn the cardboard over standing upside down (refer to the picture). Scotch tape all the sides together very firmly then tape on the handle to the side panels and staple for extra security.

Step 3.

Cut out the fairy pictures and cut up the remaining paper into small pieces. Glue on the scrap paper first to the bag including the handle then once the bag is covered glue on the fairies to complete the picture. Estapol gloss or varnish the box to make it water resistant and to give it a nice shine and allow drying time before gluing on the material flowers and butterflies, then load up your bag and go shopping.
