



# FLOWERS



Required items: Kebab sticks, Coloured paper, Coloured tissue paper (different colours), small pom poms, cake patties, scissors, glue, sticky tape.

Step 1. Curl your sheet of coloured paper into a cone shape (overlapping one side over the other side) see image and tape it into place.

Step 2. Glue a pom pom into the centre of the paper cake patty, cut out a square of tissue paper larger than the patty and glue the bottom of the patty onto the tissue paper square. Allow to dry...repeat this process for as many patties as you think you will need to fill your cone.



Step 3. Poke the kebabs sharp end through the pom pom middle and out the other side.

Step 4. Cut up a different coloured tissue paper square and thread onto the stick, add as many sheets or colours as you wish and shape (scrunch) the tissue paper to look like petals. Tape the last square sheet at the base onto the stick so the petals don't fall down, see image with purple flower.

Step 5. Add all flowers together in a bunch and tape the stems together. Cut into thin strips some A4 coloured paper along the longest side, and stuff loosely into the cone so that the ends can be seen out of the top, than add your flower bunch into the cone to complete the look. Tie around the cone with some string or ribbon to secure the flowers in the cone.
